JOB DESCRIPTION

Summary: MH-TCM services help adults with a serious and persistent mental illness (SPMI) and children with a severe emotional disturbance (SED) gain access to needed medical, social, educational, vocational, financial and other necessary services as they relate to the recipient's mental health needs. MH-TCM will carry a case load of 20 to 40 clients.

A case manager must have a bachelor's degree in one of the behavioral sciences or related fields, including but not limited to social work, psychology, or nursing from an accredited college or university; or, if without a degree, must:

QUALIFICATION AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS: To be eligible as a children's or adult's mental health case manager, an individual must meet the following criteria:

- Bachelor Degree in social work, counseling or related field from an accredited college or university. One year of full time or equivalent experience working with adults experiencing serious mental illness and or children with serious emotional disturbances.
- Has completed or agrees to complete AHCA-approved mental health targeted case management training within three months of initially providing Medicaid services.
- Have knowledge of available resources in the service area for children and or adults with serious mental illness.
- Must have a valid driver's license and auto insurance; successful motor vehicle background check; successful background screenings through local law enforcement, Florida Dept. of Law Enforcement, and FBI.
